Please spread the word about this competition and encourage people to dig out that "old" rifle that never sees the light of day and put it to the use for which it was created. If you look at the results carefully you can see that a variety of rifles make it into the medals.

Can we take this opportunity to remind you all that in the prone leagues shooting from a bench with both elbows touching the bench is acceptable (but no part of the rifle) and that orthoptic apertures may well assist you in using service sights. – this is, put simply, a small disk with a hole of about 1mm in it, fitted behind, or even in front of, your glasses or shooting prescription lens. This can be easily made at home, or an adjustable pistol type iris may also be used.
