

.22" calibre B.S.A. "SPORTSMAN" RIFLES

Although the Sportsman line of rifles has now been discontinued by the manufacturers and stocks of their Five-shot model are completely exhausted, our purchases of the two remaining models illustrated are adequate to enable us to maintain supplies for sometime to come.

These rifles were B.S.A.'s first post-war production and were sold in large quantities.

They have given first class service despite the austerity of their basic design which alone is responsible for their low price that does not reflect upon their accuracy.

B.S.A. 'SPORTSMAN-SINGLE'

Designed for single loading this makes an ideal rook or rabbit rifle for the beginner or for occasional use; takes short, long, or long rifle rim fire cartridges, but naturally is most accurate and effective when used with the latter.

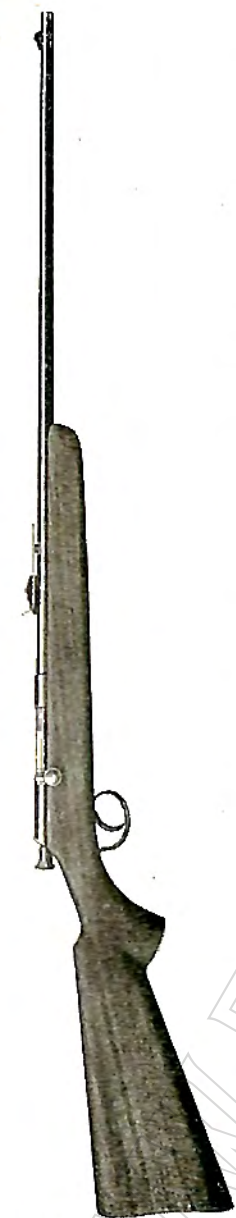
Its sturdy bolt action gives certain detonation and positive ejection.

B.S.A. 'SPORTSMAN-FIFTEEN'

Has the same general features and appearance as the single-shot model, with the addition of a fifteen-shot tubular magazine that increases its weight by approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. The standard sighting is identical comprising a blade foresight and step adjustable open rearsight.

Receiver drilled and tapped for the fitting of additional aperture sights.
